# **AFFILIATION OF MEMBER CLUBS POLICY**



## AFFILIATION OF MEMBER CLUBS POLICY

## 1. BACKGROUND

- 1.1. The Parramatta Junior League undertook a review of its constitution in 2023. In the review it was decided to remove the clauses that were operational, hence an Affiliation of Member Clubs Policy has been created.
- 1.2. A decision was made to make the Affiliation of Members Clubs more robust to protect Clubs, their Members and the Parramatta Junior League.
- 1.3. The Parramatta Junior League Constitution now reads:
  - 8.2 To maintain affiliation and have registrations open on 1 December, ALL Clubs must present by no later than 30 November each year the list of documentation required in the affiliation of member clubs policy.

## 2. <u>POLICY</u>

- 2.1. To maintain affiliation to the Parramatta Junior League and have registrations open on1 December, ALL Clubs must present by no later than 30 November the following documentation:
  - a) NSWRL & Parramatta Junior Rugby League Club Affiliation and Health Check (click here)

<u>and;</u>

2.2. Pay the Parramatta Junior League Affiliation Fee as noted in the Parramatta Junior League Affiliation Document

### <u>and;</u>

- 2.3. The NSWRL and Parramatta Junior League must be satisfied that the information provided confirms that the Club is:
  - a) compliant with the Incorporated Associations Act 2009
  - b) solvent
  - c) compliant with the Parramatta Junior League requirements for the administration of a Club (all sections of the Parramatta Junior League Affiliation Document are completed, and requirements are met)
- 2.4. Should a Club not meet the requirements of clauses 2.1, 2.2 and 2.3, they will not be affiliated to the Parramatta Junior Rugby League Club Inc. until such time as they are met.
- 2.5. Should a Club not meet the requirements by the second Friday in February, they will not be affiliated for the season.
